Addendum No. 1

Subject: Amendment No. 1 to Bid Document for Water Supply System, Filtration Plants, Tube-wells, OHRs, SCADA and Allied Works (NCB-Works/PICIIP-03 (Lot 1) in accordance with ITB 8.1, Section 1 (Instructions to Bidders) of Bidding Documents

With reference to IFB Notice dated 17 August 2020 published on 17 August 2020 and IFB published on ADB website on 18 August 2020 following amendments have been made in the various sections of the Bidding Documents under this Addendum No.1 in accordance with ITB 8.1. The addendum shall be read and construed as an integral part of the Bidding Documents and shall take precedence in case of any conflict / ambiguities in the Bidding Documents and other provisions within. The changes mentioned herein below are applicable for Contract No: NCB-Works/PICIIP-03 (Lot 1: Water Supply System, Filtration Plants, Tube-wells, OHRs, SCADA and Allied Works), unless indicated otherwise.

1. Section 2: Bid Data Sheet

- i) **ITB 7.4:** The date of pre-bid meeting is changed to “02 September 2020”.
- ii) **ITB 16.1:** The following text is added:
“Technical Proposal shall also include a Health and Safety COVID-19 Plan, in accordance with the relevant government regulations and guidelines on COVID-19 prevention and control issued by the Government of Pakistan (<http://covid.gov.pk/guideline>), or in the absence thereof, to international good practice guidelines, such as World Health Organization 2020, Considerations for public health and social measures in the workplace in the context of COVID-19, Geneva available here: <https://www.who.int/publications-detail/considerations-for-public-health-and-social-measures-in-the-workplace-in-the-context-of-covid-19>.

Absence of or incomplete submission may result in rejection of bid.”

2. Section 3: Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

- i) Table of Criteria: 1: Evaluation:
Para 1.7 “Other Criteria: is added
- ii) Following text is added under new para 1.7.

“1.7 Other Criteria

The Employer will take into account the quality of the Health and Safety COVID -19 Plan (‘the Plan’) attached to the Technical Proposal in its evaluation of the Adequacy of the Technical Proposal.

- *The bidder should demonstrate in the Plan the health and safety measures they will put in place on site in relation to COVID-19 prevention and controls,*

including but not limited to, PPE requirements, site set up, training, induction and mobilization of new personnel, equipment and plants cleaning and other hazard management measures while undertaking site work activities, site visitors health and safety protocols, as well as the approach to the monitoring and reporting of the Plan. The Plan should be fit for purpose for the particular construction works of this contract and be aligned with any relevant government regulations and guidelines on COVID-19 prevention and controls, as well as workplace safety requirements, or in the absence thereof, to international good practice guidelines such as World Health Organization 2020. Considerations for public health and social measures in the workplace in the context of COVID-19 Geneva available here: <https://www.who.int/publications-detail/considerations-for-public-health-and-social-measures-in-the-workplace-in-the-context-of-covid-19>.”

3. Section 4: Bidding Forms

- i) Table of Forms: Page 4-13 is added to include requirement of “Covid-19 Specific Site Health and Safety Management Plan”
- ii) **Bill of Quantities:** The following sentence is added to “Bill of Quantities”:
“Note: The bid price is inclusive of all Environmental, Health and Safety management and compliance cost.”
- iii) The following requirement is added on **Page 4-8, Technical Proposal, Bidding Forms** after “ Construction Schedule”.
“COVID-19 Specific Site Health and Safety Management Plan in accordance with ITB 16.1”
- iv) The requirement for following requirements is added on **Page 4-13, Bidding Forms** under the form of Construction Schedule.
“COVID-19 Specific Site Health and Safety Management Plan in accordance with ITB 16.1”

4. Section 6: Employer’s Requirements

- i) **Specifications:**
The following text is added under Specifications on Page 6-2:
“Note: The Contractor shall submit a Site Specific Environmental Management Plan (SSEMP) and Site Specific Health and Safety Management Plan (SSHSMP) in compliance with PCC, Sub Clause 4.18 and PCC, Sub Clause 6.7 respectively in Section-8.”
- iii) **Supplementary Information Regarding Works to be Procured:**
The text “Nil” under the heading on Page 6-4 is deleted and following text is added:

“The bidder shall be required to comply with relevant government regulations and guidelines on COVID-19 prevention and control issued by the Government of Pakistan (<http://covid.gov.pk/guideline>), or in the absence thereof, to international good practice guidelines, such as World Health Organization 2020, Considerations for public health and social measures in the workplace in the context of COVID-19, Geneva available here: <https://www.who.int/publications-detail/considerations-for-public-health-and-social-measures-in-the-workplace-in-the-context-of-covid-19>.”

The IEE of the for the subject package is attached.”

5. Section 8: Particular Conditions of Contract

i) Part A – Contract Data, Sub Clause 4.8

The following new text is added in Sub-clause:

4.8	Safety Procedures	After bullet point (b), add the following: “In particular, the Contractor is responsible for providing site workers with safe and healthy working conditions and establish an operating system to prevent accidents, injuries, and disease.”
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ii) Part A – Contract Data, Sub Clause 4.18

The following new text is added in Sub-clause:

4.18	Protection of the Environment	<p>At the end of the sub-clause in 4.18 Protection of the Environment, add the following paragraphs: “The Contractor shall comply with all applicable national, provincial, and local environmental laws and regulations. The Contractor shall also comply with all reasonable requests of the national and local authorities responsible for enforcing environmental controls. Within 28 days of the Commencement Date the Contractor shall submit a detailed Site Specific Environmental Management Plan (SSEMP) for the Engineer’s no objection showing how he/she intends to comply with environmental laws and regulations and other specific requirements prescribed in the Contract, addressing all the monitoring and mitigation measures set forth in the Environmental Impact Assessment (“EIA”) and the Environmental Management Plan (“EMP”) of the project attached in Section 6- Employer’s Requirements. Work shall not commence on the Site until the no objection of SSEMP has been obtained from the Engineer and is being implemented. Such acceptance by the Engineer shall not relieve the Contractor of any of his obligations or responsibilities under the Contract. The Contractor shall (a) establish an operational system for managing environmental impacts, (b) comply with the approved SSEMP and any corrective or preventative actions set out in safeguards monitoring reports that the Employer will prepare from time to time to monitor the implementation of the project EMP through the SSEMP, (c) allocate the budget required to ensure that such measures, requirements and actions are carried out, (d) submit semi-annual reports on the compliance of such measures to the Employer.</p> <p>Where unanticipated environmental risks or impacts become apparent during the Contract, the Contractor is required to update the SSEMP to outline the potential impacts to site works and associated mitigation measures for the Engineer’s approval.”</p>
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iii) Part A – Contract Data, Sub Clause 6.7

The following new text is added in Sub-clause:

6.7	Health and Safety	<p>After the first paragraph of 6.7 Health and Safety, add the following:</p> <p>“ The Contractor is responsible for establishment of preventive and emergency preparedness and response measures to avoid, and where avoidance is not possible, to minimize, adverse impacts and risks of the construction site work to the health and safety of local communities.</p> <p>Within 28 days of the Commencement Date the Contractor shall submit a detailed Site Specific Health and Safety Management Plan (SSHSMP) for the Engineer’s no objection showing how he/she intends to comply with the local Health and Safety laws and regulations and other specific requirements prescribed in the Contract, taking into account the Supplementary Information in Section 6- Employer’s Requirements. Work shall not commence on the Site until the confirmation of no objection of the SSHSMP has been obtained from the Engineer and is being implemented. Such confirmation of no objection by the Engineer shall not relieve the Contractor of any of his/her obligations or responsibilities under the Contract.</p> <p>Where unanticipated health and safety hazards or risks become apparent during the Contract, the Contractor is required to update the SSHSMP to outline the potential impacts to site works and associated mitigation measures for the Engineer’s no objection.</p> <p>The Contractor shall comply with the approved SSHSMP and any corrective or preventative actions set out in safeguards monitoring reports that the Employer will prepare from time to time to monitor the implementation of the project EMP through the SSHSMP.</p> <p>In particular, the Contractor is required to provide all personnel on site including Employer’s Personnel and visitors with personal protective equipment, including protection for feet (safety boots), head, eyes, ears (safety helmets) and hands, etc. , in accordance with the Contractor’s SSHSMP. The Contractor should ensure that his Subcontractors comply with the SSHSMP and provide all such necessary equipment to their personnel.</p> <p>The Contractor shall bear the costs to ensure that such measures, requirements and actions are carried out.</p> <p>The Contractor shall submit semi-annual reports on the compliance of such measures to the Employer.”</p>
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		<p>Add after the third paragraph the following:</p> <p>“In the event of a significant injury involving medical treatment or hospitalization and fatal accident the Contractor shall notify the Engineer immediately by verbal communication and submit a formal report as soon as practicable after its occurrence. For all accidents, whether fatal or not, the Contractor shall also notify the appropriate local authorities in accordance with the Laws of the Country.”</p>
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
